Nomination letters and forms have been sent to about 250 Central Ohio middle school and high school band directors. Please ask your band director to announce the All-Star Brass Bands opportunity during band, and post the enclosed flyer on the bulletin board, and to nominate interested students. You need to act as recruiters for the organization, since you are the only experts on the All-Stars in your school.

Rehearsals and Audition Location:

Rehearsals are on Sunday afternoon at Upper Arlington Lutheran Church (UALC) at Mill Run, 3500 Mill Run Dr., Hilliard, Ohio 43026. Junior-Varsity rehearses from 1:00-3:15pm and ASBP rehearses from 4:00-6:15pm. **Auditions are on Saturday, November 5th, from 9:00am -3:00pm**. If there is a conflict with that audition date, please call to make special arrangements for **Sunday, November 6th,** or a date prior to Sunday, November 13th).

Deadline for nominations is Thursday, October 27th.

Recruiting Scholarships:

We encourage you to nominate via the website. It is the fastest and easiest.

Need Music for Your Audition?

- Go to our website to select music and scales. (www.allstarbrass.org)
- Choose ONE lyrical selection, and ONE technical selection that you think you can play well. Prepare this music to the best of your ability.
- You will also find all the required scales with fingerings/slide positions (these scale sheets can be used for OMEA Solo and Ensemble). PLEASE MEMORIZE!
- Download, print, and practice to prepare for your audition.

Detailed Audition Requirements

Brass. Grades 7-9:

Scales- each student is required to perform 2 major scales of their choice from memory. The student must also play a one-octave chromatic scale, up and down the octave. He/she may start on any note.

Prepared excerpts- Two, 16-32 measure excerpts from band music, solo and ensemble literature, or etudes, to show lyrical and technical abilities. Current concert band audition material, solos, or private lesson excerpts are a wise choice. One lyrical and one technical piece are required. Go to our website to choose music if needed.

Sight-reading- Three short etudes, selected by the auditioner will be required of all nominees.

Brass, Grades 10-12:

Scales- each student is required to have memorized all major scales up to 4 flats and 4 sharps. The auditioner will ask for two of these scales. The student must also play a two-octave chromatic scale, up and down the octaves. He/she may start on any note.

Prepared excerpts- Two, 16-32 measure excerpts from band music, solo and ensemble literature, or etudes, to show lyrical and technical abilities. Current concert band audition material, solos, or private lesson excerpts are a wise choice. One lyrical and one technical piece are required. Go to our website to choose music if needed.

Sight-reading- Three short etudes, selected by the auditioner will be required of all nominees.

Percussion, all grades:

Scales- each student is required to have memorized all major scales up to 3 flats and 2 sharps. The auditioner will ask for two of these scales. The student must also play a two-octave chromatic scale, up and down the octaves. He/she may start on any note. Bells, xylophone, or marimba will be provided for this exercise.

Prepared excerpts- Two, 16-32 measure excerpts from band music, solo and ensemble literature, or etudes. Current concert band audition material, solos, or private lesson excerpts are a wise choice. Select music from one keyboard instrument and one percussive instrument. Go to our website to choose music if needed

Sight-reading- Three short etudes, selected by the auditioner will be required of all nominees.

Auditions: Saturday, November 5th, 9:00am - 3:00pm If there is a conflict with the audition day due to State Marching Band Finals, nominees can arrange to audition on either day (or a date prior to Sunday, November 13th).
